
**RE: PHASED REPORTING ON-CAMPUS FOR SEMESTER ONE 2020-2021  
ACADEMIC YEAR**

Following the guidance from Government and approval to receive students' cohorts on campus in a phased manner (in compliance with COVID-19 SoPs), the schedule for staggered face-to-face teaching and learning is as follows:

1. The Freshers (Year One, Undergraduate and Graduate) Orientation, Enrolment and Registration will be held between Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> – Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> February 2021 at Colleges; and thereafter, teaching and learning for academic year 2020/2021 will commence on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2021 (for 4 weeks on campus) until 27<sup>th</sup> March 2021. Online (ODEL) teaching will follow for this group up to completion.
2. Joining the Year One on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2021 will be the rest of students (Years 2,3,4,5) from Colleges of Health Sciences; Veterinary Medicine & Animal Biosecurity; the Architecture Program and 4<sup>th</sup> Year Agriculture.
3. The Year Two and other non-finalist students (who should have already started with online teaching from 8<sup>th</sup> February 2021) will report on campus for laboratory and practicums from 28<sup>th</sup> March – 24<sup>th</sup> April 2021 (4 weeks on campus).
4. Other Finalist students (who should have already started with online teaching from 8<sup>th</sup> February 2021) will report on campus for laboratory and practicums from 25<sup>th</sup> April – 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2021 (4 weeks on campus).
5. The end of Semester One examinations will follow in a staggered manner; a detailed program will be drawn in due course by the Academic Registrar/ College Registrar.
6. Each College Registrar, in consultation with the Principal, should produce a detailed plan to conduct Freshers Orientation and Registration Sessions on Campus during 22<sup>nd</sup>-27<sup>th</sup> February 2021.
