

Keynote Speaker

SAMUEL SEJJAAKA (CPA)

Prof. Samuel Sejjaaka is a Ugandan accountant, academic and businessman. He is a partner in Sejjaaka, Kaawaase & Company, Certified Public Accountants.

Between 1991 and 2014, he lectured at Uganda's oldest tertiary institution, Makerere University (later the Makerere University Business School) and rose to the position of Deputy Principal.

He then helped establish Abacus Business School, Uganda's premier executive education institution which merged in 2019 with Management and Accountancy Training Company (MAT). He is the current Country Team Leader/ Principal of MAT ABACUS Business School.

Prof. Sejjaaka's experience encompasses over 25 years' experience in management and directorship, including governance and oversight of public interest companies, supervision of assurance functions and strategy formulation for growth.
